Career Pathways, A Public Charter Secondary School to Lease Hamline Office Park in St. Paul.

A career focused charter secondary school (gr6-12) now in it's third year, is moving into the building at 1355 Pierce Butler Route in the Hamline - Midway neighborhood of St. Paul.

St. Paul, Minnesota, August 7, 2017 - Career Pathways, previously located in the Whittier Park neighborhood of Mpls. will be opening its doors to students on September 6th in St. Paul. Career Pathways, beginning its third school year, has relocated to St. Paul in close proximity to a wide variety of industries and post-secondary schools where students will participate in internships, jobs, and postsecondary education opportunities (PSEO).

“We are thrilled to be moving into the Hamline - Midway neighborhood because the community has so many opportunities to offer our students,” reports Career Pathways School Board Member, Liz Lonetti. “The building will allow us to create workshop, aquaponics, and technical training labs in and around the school.”

Career Pathways students are exposed to multiple career opportunities through Minnesota Department of Education approved coursework with an emphasis on real-world application of transferable skills. Our students are out in the community with Street Law, YouthBuild, Resources Inc. concurrent enrollment at Lake Superior College, and certified nursing assistant training to channel their passions and skill for the common good.

Students in grades 7 to 12 are welcome to participate in Minnesota State High School League girls and boys soccer and basketball through a co-op team with other charter schools in Mpls.

A unique component of Career Pathways is a strong English Language Learner (ELL) program designed to serve all levels of English Language Learners. Newcomers as well as students born in the US with English as their second or third language, find success in the personalized Career Pathways ELL classrooms.

As a public school, Career Pathways does not discriminate and is open to all students who wish to attend. Advisory based, small class size (15-20 students), Genius Hour, Maker-Space, Design Thinking, personalized learning, individualized graduation plans, community service and work credit are some of the school's unique features.

The personalized programming at Career Pathways supports individual student needs. Career Pathways will always be a small school where every student is known. Enrollment is capped at 175 with a waiting list available for future applicants when the cap is met. Enrollment is now open on the school website
